

Uniforms & Equipment

Week 1

- Duty Belt*
 - Holster
 - Magazine Pouches
 - Handcuff case
 - Handcuffs
 - Keepers
 - Baton holder or ring (if applicable)
 - Baton (if applicable)
 - OC Holster (if applicable)
 - CED Holster (if applicable)
- Academy grey uniform shirt, pants, black tie & black shoes or boots (shined)
- Ballistic vest
- Agency jacket, Agency or black watch cap, black duty gloves
- Notebook & note-taking materials

*Recruits from non-uniformed agencies are not required to have a patrol-style duty belt

Week 2

- Academy** T-shirt & sweat shirt, navy blue BDUs, black boots
- Agency jacket, Agency or black watch cap, black duty glove
- Duty pistol - strong preference for the weapon to be the same issued upon graduation
- Three or more handgun magazines
- Pistol storage box – lockable hard plastic or metal
- 3,600 rounds of factory handgun ammunition equivalent to service ammunition
- 500 rounds of agency service/duty ammunition
- Moist towelettes (for de-leading)
- Weapon Cleaning Kit
- Proper foul weather gear

**Recruits academy original navy blue T-shirt/sweatshirt is acceptable

Week 3

- Department shotgun with sling
- Department patrol rifle with sling
- Three or more patrol rifle magazines
- 50 rounds 12 gauge 00 buck (or agency service/duty shotgun round)
- 20 rounds 12 gauge slug
- 1000 rounds patrol rifle duty ammunition or equivalent
- 200 rounds of agency patrol rifle service/duty ammunition

Please note: The Rockland County Police Academy has a safe weapon storage facility. After Initial Firearms Training, Recruit handguns can be stored at the Academy (with access limited to Academy Staff *only*) until the end of Phase 2 or returned upon completion of Firearms according to agency preference.
