Description: This two-day course will expose Illicit and Abused drugs, emerging drugs, drugs which are constantly modified to stay under the radar of the law, and the constant counterfeiting of prescription drugs killing Americans everyday across this country. Officers will learn the how to identify and understand the individual hazards that each substance presents from the traffic stop, calls for service, working undercover, or processing a drug-related search warrant. Officers will learn how each substance fits into the five classes under the Controlled Substances Act (CSA) from narcotics, depressants, stimulants, hallucinogens and anabolic steroids. Each officer will build drug paraphernalia props during the course to further their knowledge of how paraphernalia is used.

Topics covered: Fentanyl and other Synthetic opioids, Counterfeit Prescription Drugs, Research Chemicals Phenibut, Etizolam, Flakka, visual recognition of each controlled substance, The common dosage unit for each substance, routes of ingestion for each substance, Packaging and paraphernalia+ much more!!

Who should attend: All Law Enforcement officers, Investigators, Corrections, Patrol, Parole, Probation, Narcotics Officers, Military Police, Security Forces, Investigators, and others.

INSTRUCTOR: William "Bill" Loucks Jr, retired from the Metro Nashville (TN) Police Department and has been training law enforcement officers across the US ever since. He is a nationally recognized drug identification and clandestine lab expert and has testified as a drug expert in local, state and federal courts.
