Description: The Instructor Evaluator Workshop was designed to ensure that the quality

of law enforcement instruction throughout the state remains high. The instructional skills and techniques of our training cadre are periodically evaluated by trained evaluators to maintain that high quality. The properly trained evaluator will consistently apply standardized evaluation guidelines when assessing the presentation skills of a fellow instructor and

submit report to the Division of Criminal Justice Services.

Although there is no set minimum number of years an individual must be an MPTC Certified General Topics Instructor before enrolling in an Instructor Evaluator Course, it is strongly recommended that each instructor evaluator candidate have significant experience providing classroom instruction to law enforcement and possesses excellent communication skills. The workshop portion of the presentation requires the review of recorded examples of other instructors' presentations. The students will be required to view portions of the recorded presentations, rate the presentations using the Instructor Evaluator Checklist, and have

a group discussion of their ratings.
