## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Asset forfeiture is a very powerful tool used by law enforcement agencies, including those at the Federal, State and Local level, against criminals and crime organizations to deprive them of their ill-gotten gains through seizure of these assets.

The course on Asset Forfeiture for Law Enforcement is designed to provide comprehensive training to law enforcement officers on the legal framework, procedures, and best practices related criminal and civil asset forfeiture. This course aims to enhance officers' knowledge and skills in interdiction investigations and drafting probable cause affidavits related to seizures.

**Participants** will become familiar with constitutional principles, statutory provisions, and case law that govern asset forfeiture. They will gain a thorough understanding of the Fourth Amendment and its application to asset forfeiture.

**Participants** will receive instruction in the necessary procedural requirements.

**Participants** will learn proper documentation, including affidavits, probable cause, and effective report writing.

**Participants** will receive instruction on courtroom testimony regarding asset forfeiture proceedings.

**By the end of this course, participants** will possess a comprehensive understanding of Asset Forfeiture equipped with the knowledge and skills necessary to lawfully seize contraband articles and to ensure a successful forfeiture and final award to their agency.
