INFORMATION FOR SPONSORING AGENCIES

The Rockland County Police & Public Safety Academy (RCP&PSA) will host a DCJS Basic School for Police Officers (BCPO) starting on **February 5**, **2024**, with an anticipated graduation date of **June 28**, **2024**.

The RCP&PSA will likely be offering a Radar/Lidar Operator Course following the completion of the BCPO.

The attached registration form should be completed and faxed as soon as possible in order to have all necessary information in place prior to the start of the course. By Monday, January 22, 2024, the Academy office must have:

ADVISORY:

Agencies **MUST** provide one vehicle for every four recruits to be used by the Recruit Class on the closed-track EVOC Course during the EVOC training on April 20 and 21, 2024.

PHYSICAL FITNESS

The Municipal Police Training Council has established physical standards for the Basic Course for Police Officers. The test is scored on a curve based on the age and gender of the recruit. These standards were designed to conform to the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Rockland County Police Academy requires a minimum of the 50th percentile for graduation.

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In addition to passing the Physical Fitness standards, NYS DCJS mandates that all recruits participate in a minimum number of hours of Physical Training during the Basic Course.

In the event that you fall well below the minimum physical fitness standards during the test given on the first day, Academy personnel will notify and place you in a remedial physical training program. You will be advised that you are in jeopardy of not completing the Basic Course for Police Officers.

A fitness guide for you to use in preparation for the academy is available on the academy website (www.rocklandcountypoliceacademy.com/information-for-agencies). You should arrive on Day One familiar with the PT test standards and the basic exercises you will be performing.

IMPORTANT HEALTH NOTICE

Potential recruits should be aware of a health risk associated with engaging in an intense physical training program. **RHABDOMYOLYSIS** is a breakdown of muscle tissue during intense exercise that can cause a release of protein into the blood stream that kidneys are unable to process, resulting in kidney failure.

Contributing factors include:

Sudden increase of exercise Dehydration

Stimulants (especially in liquid form)

Nutritional Supplements

High ambient temperatures Alcohol

Illnesses with flu-like symptoms Certain prescription drugs

Recruit must be aware that general fitness is not protective or predictive for rhabdomyolysis.

Some recommendations to avoid this condition are conditioning to exercise and drinking plenty of fluids. Any recruit who feels dizzy or disoriented should stop and rest. Any incidence of dark urine requires consultation with a physician before exercise continues.

Recruits must arrive the first day in *proper business attire* (i.e., suit-and-tie) and have:

- Department patch centered on left sleeve ¾ inch from shoulder seam
- Academy patch (available at Academy Office) centered on right sleeve $\frac{3}{4}$ inch from shoulder seam
(2) Gray uniform trousers
- Seams can not be sown into pants, they must be capable of being pressed
Black clip-on tie
Black 1 ¾ garrison belt with a silver buckle
Black socks
Black boots (capable of being shined)
Police duty jacket
- For non-uniformed agencies: dark all-weather waist length jacket
Black cold weather gloves
Black military-style knit watch cap
Navy blue Poly/Cotton Shorts: Academy logo silkscreened on left leg
Navy blue T-shirts: Academy logo silkscreened on left chest
- Recruit's last name in 2-inch white letters on back
Navy blue sweatpants: Academy logo silkscreened on left leg
Navy blue sweatshirts: Academy logo silkscreened on left chest
- Recruit's last name in 2-inch white letters on back
Navy Blue hat with Academy patch
- Academy patch (patches are available at Hollywood Screen Printing) – centered on front.
Running shoes: black, gray, or blue
Blue BDU-style trousers
Yellow reflective military-style PT belt
Athletic mouth guard, black, blue, or clear (Shock Doctor Gel Max Power or similar)
6-inch 3 ring blue binder
A refillable water bottle (Camelbak Chute Mag, 32 oz, Oxford Blue)
A hardcopy or electronic copy of the agency Patrol Guide, Standard Orders, or Standard Operating
Procedure.

EQUIPMENT CONTINUED

By the start of the second week (*latest*), Recruits from all agencies need:

<u>Please note:</u> The Rockland County Police & Public Academy has a safe weapon storage facility. After Initial Firearms Training, Recruit handguns will be stored at the Academy (with access limited to Academy Firearms Instructional Staff *only*) so that recruits may practice safe weapons manipulation drills under supervision during the Basic Course for Police Officers. Weapons can be issued by Academy staff for specific agency purposes (e.g., supplemental firearms training or when required for traveling in a marked department vehicle).

Once a recruit's weapon is lodged with the academy, it is the policy of the RCP&PSA that only the chief executive of an agency may order the weapon to be released prior to graduation. This order must be in writing, specify the reason for the release of the weapon and is non-delegable.
